Our Learning Journey

This term's topic is all about Our Feathered Friends. We will be learning to classify different types of vertebrates and invertebrates, and will be investigating where birds live and how this relates to climates and weather patterns. What's more, will explore how to recognise and distinguish between various types of birdcall.

We will also continue to teach spelling and sentence-building regularly, while also continuing to build our pupil's reading fluency and comprehension skills.

Maths

We are finishing our units on multiplication and division and will then be moving onto recapping shape, fractions, money and time, which we have been learning in small chunks throughout year 2.

Multiplication - Counting in 2s, 5s, 10s and making arrays Division - by grouping and sharing Fractions - Halves and quarters of shapes and numbers.

Science

Feeding and Exercise: We are finishing off the year by looking at how we keep our bodies fit and healthy. We will be looking at the basic needs of humans and animals, and apply this to our chick hatching project. We will also describe simple food chains, and the importance of a healthy diet and hygiene.

Other Curriculum Areas

Mega Mile: This year, the children will be running the 'Mega Mile' on Tuesday as part of our school's commitment to healthy living. Please ensure that your child wears suitable footwear on this day.

PSHE
