English

Reading

This term, we will continue reading Trash which is set in a fictitious country loosely inspired by children who live in the Philippines working in dumpsites. We will explore themes of poverty, friendship and corruption.

Writing

Over the next few weeks, we will be using Varmints, a short story and film about an environmental catastrophe, to explore how atmosphere can be created and suddenly changed so that our reader goes on a poignant and tense journey with our main characters. By the end of the topic, the children will plan and write their own disaster story where their main character is caught in the middle of a wild fire.

Maths

Our maths learning this half term includes:

- Ratio
- Algebra
- Statistics

Science

The children will conclude their science in year 6 focusing on light and sight. Expect lots of practical experiments where the children explore how light travels, why shadows change and how they are formed, as well as understanding how we see objects.

The British Empire

This half-term, we will continue our British Empire topic. The learning will mainly have a history focus as we explore why Britain once ruled the largest empire the world has ever seen. We will also explore the cultural impact of the empire, looking at influences in art and music and how it's evolved over time.
