Sports Leaders

10 girls and boys will be selected from Years 6 to be Sports Leaders. A number of these children are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Their duties include:

- Helping with sport clubs
- Supporting younger children
- Writing match reports
- Keeping the equipment cupboard in order
- Leading/setting up activities at lunchtimes including zoning of the playground
- Collecting the equipment at the end of lunchtime
- Organising Challenge day

Swimming

Swimming outcomes 2018 by the end of year 6 - 82% of children could

- swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres
- use a range of strokes effectively
- perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations

Extra Curricular Activities:

A senior teacher leads the organisation of all extra-curricular activities to ensure that over the academic year, each child has the opportunity (where possible) to attend at least one extra curricular activity. Some of the sporting provision includes: football, basketball, karate, netball, multi-sports, street dance, hockey, and skateboarding
