10 girls and boys will be selected from Years 5 & 6 to be Sports Leaders. A number of these children are in receipt of Pupil Premium funding. Their duties include:

- ✓✓ Keeping the equipment cupboard in order
  
- ✓✓ Leading/setting up activities at lunchtimes

#### Extra Curricular Activities:

Since September 2013, there has been a vast improvement in the quantity and quality of extra curricular provision. The PE lead also leads the organisation of all extra-curricular activities to ensure that over the academic year, each child has the opportunity (where possible) to attend at least one extra curricular activity. Some of the sporting provision includes: football, basketball, karate, netball, multi-sports, street dance, hockey, and skateboarding. The PE lead has also promoted external clubs and has encouraged children to join. He has also organised trials at district level. We also run an adult fitness class weekly for parents, teachers and adults in the local community.
