THIS TERM OUR NEW TOPIC IS RAINFORESTS

Year 2 Learning Letter

LITERACY

The focus of our Literacy learning will be non-chronological reports (non-fiction). We will start to look at language features of non-chronological reports. The children will also be researching different rainforest animals and taking notes. Internet research at home is a great way to support your child with their learning.

MATHS

During the next two weeks, we will be finishing our unit on money: adding different amounts and calculating change. We will then be moving on to

Multiplication and Division

- Recall and use multiplication and division facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table
- Calculate mathematical statements for multiplication and division using the correct symbols
- Solve word problems
- Show that multiplication of two numbers can go in any order

SCIENCE

After looking at 'living things', the children will be moving on to Habitats and how animals across the globe adapt to their different surrounding and environments.
