Year 4 Learning Letter

NEW TOPIC - Japan

This term's topic is Japan and we will be investigating Japanese culture, geography, history, language and food. Over the next few weeks, we will be producing lots of Japanese inspired art and learning about key artists such as Hokusai.

LITERACY & READING

Our whole class reading this term will be focusing on Kensuke's Kingdom by Michael Morpurgo. We will be using this to inspire our literacy lessons as we focus on writing adventure stories.

SCIENCE
