Forest School News

Each week Year 1 and 2 attend a Forest School session and we have opened up the Golden Garden area to all classes once every three weeks. Year 1 have been learning the Forest School ethos as they get used to the space and our rules outside. They have made links to Science by observing the changing seasons, being creative with leaves and becoming mud friendly! Year 2 have focused on Habitats, making their own log piles and checking for all the living things they could find. They will continue to visit these habitats. They have also been learning to make dens using a number of stacking techniques using both large and small twigs and sticks. In the final session of the half term, they had a fire and all children had the opportunity to toast their own marshmallow.
