Welcome back. We hope you have had a restful Easter holiday and are looking forward to this summer term as much as we are.

This week's Assembly

At the start of every term, we like to revisit our rules of ready, respectful and safe and our three core values of friendship, responsibility and empathy. We have asked the children what these look like in the classroom, around the school and in the playground. We also introduced our international learning with a focus on Africa. We want our children to understand that Africa is a continent of many countries and languages that is rich in history. We briefly touched upon the repatriation of the Benin Bronzes to Nigeria as our very own Horniman Museum was in the news over the Easter holidays about this. We learnt that Africa has over 1500 languages, it has snow and ski resorts and that it is separated from Europe by just 9 miles.

OPAL

Children have a right to play Article 31. We are an OPAL school. This stands for outdoor play and learning. Children spend 20% of their school life at play and we believe that this should be a rich and valued experience. When Covid guidance changes, we hope to open up more areas for play and to allow our year groups to mix. Play is a regular item on our pupil parliament agenda and they have plans to ask the PTA to fund the building of a large sandpit and for an in-ground trampoline. 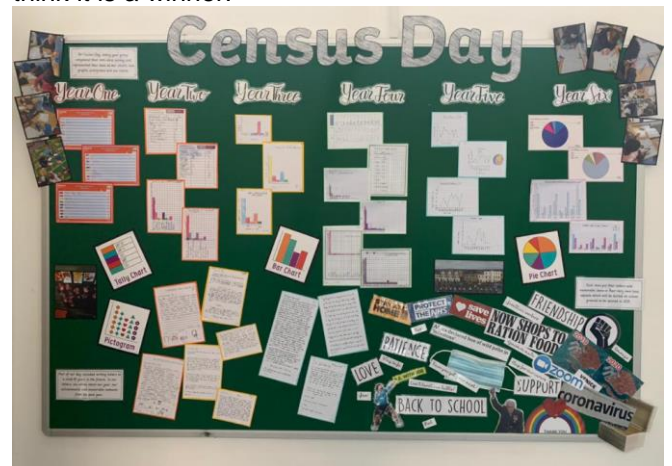
