# **School Reminders**

# **Dr Bike Free Bicycle Safety Check**

Dr Bike is a free bicycle safety check including adjustments and basic repair. They will be in school on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> November. Children can leave their bikes, unlocked, in the staff car park on the day for their safety check.

# **Starting Reception**

Children born between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2018 and 31<sup>st</sup> August 2019 are eligible to start school in September 2023. Applications can be made online between 1<sup>st</sup> September 2022 – 15<sup>st</sup> January 2023.

## School Lunches and Dinner Money

Lunches cost £2.30 a day. Lunch money for the second half of the term is £80.50 Please pay via ParentPay. Please be aware that packed lunches are to contain NO nuts, sweets, chocolate bars, fizzy drinks, or peanut butter sandwiches. #### **Absence from School**

If your child is absent from school due to sickness, or any other reason, we must be informed before **8.45am** on the first day of absence and **everyday thereafter**. Please report your child's absence on the designated absence line, or email <a href="mailto:fmarbaix@fairlawnschool.net">fmarbaix@fairlawnschool.net</a> explaining the reason for absence. If your child is suffering from diarrhoea or vomiting, they cannot be in school until 48 hours after the last bout of the illness.

## Requesting days off

If you need to request an absence for your child, for any reason, excluding medical appointments, you need to request permission from the Head Teacher. School starts at **8:45 am.** We are marking your child as late if they arrive after 8:55am. If your child arrives 10 minutes late every day, that adds up to almost an hour of school lost every single week!
