Our Learning Journey

History: Londinium

We are beginning our year with a history-based topic called 'Londinium'. We will set the context of what London was like before and when the Romans invaded, with a focus on Boudicca's Revolt, before finding out about some of the key changes the Roman invasion made.

For the two outdoor learning sessions, please ensure that your child brings suitable clothing on these days, including wellies and waterproof clothing.

English

Spellings -

Our spelling focusses will be:

'ow' phoneme spelled ou (e.g. sound)

'u' phoneme spelled ou (e.g. touch)

'i' phoneme spelled y (e.g. myth)

Words ending with sure (e.g. measure)

Words ending with ture (e.g. creature)

Reading

This year, we will be continuing with our whole class model of teaching reading, where we share multiple copies of a text. There are four sessions during the week and hearing children reading aloud is part of the process. We would encourage you to read daily with your child at home and if you would like your child to borrow books from our class library to support this, please send them in with a green Fairlawn book bag.

Writing

This year, we are using a new approach to the teaching of writing called 'The Write Stuff', which was trialled very successfully in school in the latter part of last year. The texts Year 3 will be basing their writing around this half term are 'The Secret of Black Rock' (narrative) and 'Skeletons and Muscles' (non-fiction).

Maths

We started off learning about Roman numerals as it fits so well with our Londinium topic. Other maths focus areas will be addition and subtraction first, making sure children are secure with end of Year 2 concepts and then place value of 3-digit numbers to 1000. The Maths Home Learning sent home each Friday (beginning next week) will give you a picture of what this looks like in school.

Science

In science we are studying 'Movement and Feeding'. We will be learning about nutrition for humans and other animals. We will also learn about the skeletal and muscle systems, discovering the role of these systems and how they work.

PPA

Our non-contact time will be on Friday mornings. Miss Brown will be taking the classes for art/DT and Mr Gomez will be teaching outdoor games.
