Our Learning Journey

History: Vile Victorians

This half-term, we will be learning about Queen Victoria herself as well as life in Victorian London, the British Empire and the social and technological changes of the era.

Outdoor Learning

English

Reading

We will continue to follow the whole class model of teaching reading, beginning with Wild Boy and the Black Terror by Rob Lloyd Jones. We would, as always, encourage you to read with your child on a regular basis.

Writing

Our current topic is based around the book and short film 'The Fantastic Flying Books of Mr. Morris Lessmore' written by William Joyce. It is a fiction unit and by the end of the topic, the children will be able to write an adventure narrative using a range of sentence structures and literary devices that capture the readers' imagination.

Maths

Our maths learning this half term includes:

- Number: Decimal Fractions
 - Tenths/hundredths as part of a whole
 - Tenths/hundredths as a decimal fraction
 - Counting in tenths/hundredths in different ways
 - Describe and write decimal numbers with tenths/hundredths
 - Compare and order decimal numbers with tenths/hundredths
 - Explain that decimal numbers with tenths/hundredths can be composed additively and multiplicatively
 - Calculate decimal numbers within and across one whole
 - Calculate decimal numbers with mental methods
 - Calculate decimal numbers using column addition and subtraction
 - Round decimals with tenths/hundredths to the nearest whole
 - Round decimals with hundredths to the nearest tenth
 - Using decimal place value to convert between and compare metres and centimetres
 - Calculate decimal numbers up to and bridging one tenth
 - Read and write numbers with up to 3 decimal places
 - Compare and order numbers with up to 3 decimal places

Science

This term the children will be leaning about the varied life cycles of different organisms.
