Reception Learning Letter

Friday 3rd November 2023

MATHS - Areas of learning this half term will focus on; 'The Fiveness of Five,' securing counting skills, the composition of numbers to 5 and looking at and comparing amounts. We will also look at 2D shapes and their properties.

FOREST SCHOOL - Forest School will continue this half term in all weathers. The Golden Garden can be particularly muddy at this time of year so please continue to send your child in wearing full waterproofs and a plastic bag for their muddy kit. Spare socks are a must too please.

PHONICS - We will be finishing learning our phase 2 graphemes and introduce some tricky words. A tricky word is a word that is not phonetically decodable. and is therefore just learned as a whole. During phonics lessons we are practising our letter formation and starting to spell some 3 letter words. Please support your children to practise their letter formation at home too. They could do so in sand or flour, or with pen and paper to practise their pencil grip too. Please note: the children are not taught cursive writing in Reception.

Reception NATIVITY - This term, Reception will be performing 'A Miracle in Town' for our Christmas nativity. We will send out information about costumes nearer the time.

GENERAL REMINDERS - Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the winter weather (e.g.: warm waterproof coats and shoes) and remember to label your child's clothing, including hats, scarfs and gloves. Please can you also make sure that your child has a change of spare clothes that they can keep on their peg.

JUNK MODELLING - We welcome clean donations of cardboard boxes in all shapes and sizes (up to a cereal box) and small plastic containers. Please hand to your teacher at the gate.
