Our Learning Journey

Happy New Year and welcome back. We hope you all had a good, relaxing holiday and we are excited to welcome your children back for an exciting term of learning.

This term, our traditional tale focus is The Gingerbread Man and we will bring this to life in many ways such as baking Gingerbread Men. We have also arranged for Becky from Beanstalk Arts to come in with her Cello and Ukulele for a lively musical re-telling of this popular story.

Ahoy Me Hearties! Our other topic is *Under the Sea*. We will read information books to learn some fascinating facts about these wonderful creatures. We will also be learning all about the swashbuckling world of pirates.

The children will be making and writing their own simple fact books and we will start to encourage them to extend the quantity of their writing. When you are reading with your child, it would be helpful if you could start to point out full stops at the end of sentences.

We will also celebrate Chinese New Year in February, when the new lunar year of the dragon begins. If you would like to come into class to support with this learning, please let us know.

Outdoor Learning

As a whole school, we are stopping our Forest School sessions in the garden for this half term to give the ground a chance to recover in time for Spring. We will continue to have free flow play between the indoor and outdoor classrooms, and have plans for exciting nature-themed activities in our play space.

English: Reading and Phonics

We will be learning Phase 3 sounds, focusing on the diagraphs and trigraphs as well as tricky words.

We will continue to send home information sheets about these. We will continue hearing your child read 3 times a week and will send home their group reading book on a Friday for them to read to you. Please ensure this is always returned to school on a Monday so it can be used by another child.

Maths

This term, we will be continuing to subitise numbers up to 6, as well as matching numerals to representations whilst understanding the meaning of 'one more'. We will also be focusing on the composition of numbers up to 7 and investigating the 'part-part whole.' relationship. As part of our shape, space and measure learning, we will be focusing on length, height and time.

General Reminders
