English:

This half-term, we will be developing our narrative writing skills using Roald Dahl's 'Charlie and the Chocolate Factory' as inspiration.

Reading:

We will be continuing our whole class model of teaching reading this term, focusing on our exciting, new class novel, 'Who Let The Gods Out'. As always, we encourage you to read with your child regularly at home.

Maths:

Multiplication and division - children will use their existing knowledge of times tables to solve problems and develop their knowledge of divisibility rules.

Area - children will learn how to calculate the area of regular shapes, building on their existing knowledge of perimeter.

Science:

This half-term, we will be learning about digestion. This will involve lots of practical exploration: making models of the digestive system and learning about teeth.

Oracy:

Oracy will start in Spring 1. Children will be asked to choose a piece of text to read in front of the class. More information on oracy will be sent home soon.
