## Our Learning Journey

### Geography: Natural disasters

This half-term, we will be learning about Natural Disasters, specifically Earthquakes and Volcanos. We will be delving deep into earthquakes and learning about tectonic plates and the causes of earthquakes. As geographers, we will also look at why the most powerful earthquakes in the world do not necessarily cause the most deaths and destruction.

#### Reading

We will continue to the follow the whole class model of teaching reading, beginning with our new novel 'Wolfstongue' by Sam Thompson, who will also be speaking to both classes via Zoom at the end of the term. We will also be reading non-fiction texts linked to our curriculum including a non-fiction reports on Pompei and Chila Kumari Singh Burman, an artist we will be taking inspiration from.

We would, as always, encourage you to read with your child on a regular basis.

Class Novels: 5E - Impossible Creatures by Katherine Rundell. 5T - The Wizards of Once by Cressida **Cowell**.

#### Writing

Our current topic is a mystery fiction unit based around The Nowhere Emporium' by Ross Mackenzie. By the end of the topic, the children will be able to use a range of sentence structures and literary devices to capture the readers' attention and imagination.

#### <u> Writing Journals</u>

In Year 5, the children have been given Writing Journals' to use over the coming term to boost'writing for pleasure'. Inside the journal are lots of ideas and types of writing children could complete if they so wish. This writing is optional. Their writing home learning tasks should now be completed in these books.

#### Maths

Our maths learning this half term includes: Short multiplication and short division; Area and scaling

#### Science

This term, the children will be leaning about 'Separating Mixtures.' During this unit, we will deepen our understanding of solids, liquids and gases by exploring ways in which mixtures can be separated and by planning investigations.
