Around The World: India

This half-term our learning journey is centred around India, with a focus on geography. English

Reading

We will continue to follow the whole class model of teaching reading. After spending some more time with Varjak Paw, we will be using Grandpa Chatterji by Jamila Gavin as our main text. We would, as always, encourage you to read with your child on a regular basis. The children are welcome to borrow books from our class and school libraries to support with this.

Writing

This half term, we will be completing our narrative unit based around Star In A Jar with the children's independent writing which continues the story. Afterwards, we have a non-fiction focus linked to an explanation text: How A Robot Dog Works.

Maths

Our maths learning this half term focuses on column addition and subtraction and fractions. Your child's maths home learning will continue to provide a window into the detail of the aspects and methods covered in lessons.

Our times tables fluency focus is on combined facts from 2, 4 and 8x tables.

Science

This half term, the children will continue learning about plants - the different parts of a flowering plant and their functions, the life cycle of flowering plants and different forms of seed dispersal.
