This half-term, we will be developing our non-fiction, report writing skills using Cressida Cowell's Wizard of Once' as inspiration.

# Reading:

We will be continuing our whole class model of teaching reading this term, focusing on our exciting, new class novel 'Kensuke's Kingdom'. As always, we encourage you to read with your child regularly at home.

#### Maths:

**Fractions** - Year 4 will be developing and securing their knowledge of fractions. They will be learning about part-whole relationships, mixed numbers, improper fractions and addition and subtraction of fractions.

Symmetry - Year 4 will be exploring symmetrical patterns, finding lines of symmetry in 2D shapes using a mirror and reflecting polygons.

#### Science

This half-term, we will be continuing our learning about living things, focusing on food chains and the dangers to their environments.
